# **Executive Summary**

## **Brief Introduction**

PopUpShow, (formerly Cultural Enhancement for Valencia County Elders, CEVE) is a program designed to bring live music performances to our community. We began with over 52 events in five Valencia County Senior centers in 2024. We've now expanded to the Belen Public Library, and a variety of venues serving seniors, veterans and folks of all abilities.

The benefits of music as therapy is realized weekly, are well-documented and are widely recognized in the social sciences. Music has the unique ability to connect with individuals on a deeply emotional level and has been proven to: improve cognitive function, enhance emotional well-being, promote social interaction, boost physical health, provide cultural enrichment, and support local artists.

## **Summary of major achievements and successes**

PopUpShow began 2025 with the objective of expanding our reach by including new venues throughout New Mexico. Included in this objective was an expansion of our scope originally specified as Valencia County, to PopUpShow now serving many NM Communities from Santa Fe to Socorro! Throughout the year, the connections and relationships grown between PopUpShow and various community institutions has seen venue expansion into the Belen Public Library, an increased collaboration with Valencia County Literacy Council and their literacy services, and another NM Arts grant will support more events at American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) posts.

Our initial community of Valencia County seniors, has been expanded to include people with cognitive and physical disabilities, seniors, and disadvantaged populations across New Mexico. We have partnered with SpecialOrchestra ([specialorchestra.org](http://specialorchestra.org)), Adelante ([goadelante.org](http://goadelante.org)) and La Vida Felicidad to provide regular programming. Our organization is honored and humbled to have innovated, to meet the needs of the community.

At the beginning of the year, our organization was gaining traction in the community. We had a renewed ability to recruit musicians and bands to meet the needs of our aggressive schedule of over one-hundred events throughout the year. As the schedule progressed, contacts were made, and the word got out. Beginning with one musician, PopUpShow founder Tony DeNardo who performed most of his events pro-bono,

PopUpShow was able to recruit a roster of established musicians and bands whom have already helped in 2025, and look forward to a full schedule in 2026.

## Key metrics

Between 1 Jan and 31 Dec, 2025, PopUpShow has facilitated 144 events at eleven different venues, and has already performed for many thousands in our community.

# Mission and Vision

## Statement of the organization's mission

PopUpShow seeks to promote live musical events at senior/community centers, American Legion Posts, VFW Halls, various Retirement Community clubhouses and facilities that provide day programming for people with cognitive and physical disabilities. Leveraging local artists with a strong commitment to local enrichment through musical talents, we have enhanced the experiences of the diverse members of our community. Our initiative involves organizing two-hour performances, several each week, for a total of over 140 live-music performances each year. This ongoing schedule combined with our increased reach and scope, ensures that a greater segment of our community has the opportunity to benefit from these programs.

The therapeutic benefits of live-music for seniors has been well-documented and are widely recognized in the field of gerontology. Music has the unique ability to connect with individuals on a deeply emotional level and has been proven to:

1. *Improve Cognitive Function:* Live-music can stimulate memory recall and cognitive function, helping seniors maintain mental acuity.
2. *Enhance Emotional Well-being:* Live music performances have the power to uplift spirits, reduce stress, and combat feelings of loneliness and depression.
3. *Promote Social Interaction:* These events will encourage seniors to come together, fostering a sense of community and reducing isolation.
4. *Boost Physical Health:* Engaging with music can lead to increased physical activity, such as dancing or tapping along, which can promote physical well-being.
5. *Provide Cultural Enrichment:* A diverse musical repertoire will introduce seniors to various musical styles, offering a valuable cultural experience.
6. *Support Local Artists:* By investing in local talent, we not only provide our seniors with exceptional entertainment but also contribute to the livelihood of a valued community member.

PopUpShow is committed to the well-being of our senior citizens, and becoming an integral part of our community.

The therapeutic benefits of live-music for veterans has also been well-documented and are widely recognized in the field of psychology. Again, music has the unique ability to connect with individuals on a deeply emotional level and has been proven to:

1. *Emotional and Mental Health Improvement:*

- *Reduces PTSD Symptoms:* live-music has been shown to significantly lower symptoms of PTSD, including anxiety and emotional numbness.
- *Enhances Mood:* Engaging in live-music can elevate mood by triggering the release of dopamine, a neurotransmitter linked to pleasure.
- *Stress Reduction:* Music can calm the mind and body, helping to lower heart rate and reduce stress hormones.

2. *Non-Verbal Expression and Processing Trauma:*

- *Safe Emotional Outlet:* live-music allows veterans to express emotions non-verbally, which can be especially beneficial for those who find it difficult to talk about their experiences.
- *Trauma Processing:* The emotional and sensory nature of music helps veterans confront and process traumatic memories in a controlled environment.

3. *Social Connection and Community Building:*

- *Fosters Relationships:* Group music-making activities help veterans build trust and friendships, reducing feelings of isolation.
- *Reinforces Identity:* Participating in live-music can help veterans reclaim a sense of identity outside of military service, allowing them to discover new roles as musicians or mentors.

4. *Skill Development and Personal Growth:*

- *Skill Acquisition:* Veterans learn to play instruments or engage in songwriting, which can boost self-esteem and provide a sense of accomplishment.
- *Coping Mechanisms:* live-music teaches veterans to channel stress and emotions into creative expression, enhancing resilience and coping skills.

These benefits collectively support the overall well-being of veterans, helping them reintegrate into civilian life with renewed purpose and confidence.

The therapeutic benefits of live-music for music is particularly beneficial for individuals with disabilities, including those with intellectual and developmental challenges. to enhance emotional, physical, and cognitive well-being.

## Vision for the future

Having already expanded into several new performance venues and growing our targeted community in 2025, PopUpShow is looking forward to securing a sustainable funding model in 2026. Multiple live music acts at a particular venue attracts a diverse crowd to that space, and moving the acts throughout the County to multiple venues exposes a new audience to their talent. Continued growth in our venue footprint throughout New Mexico, adding new bands/musicians to our roster, and engaging with the diversity in our community will continue to be primary objectives of our organization.

PopUpShow's second year saw the organization's expansion of our Board of Directors (BOD) that included the founder, Tony DeNardo, plus four dedicated and talented Directors who came from different backgrounds and each bring ideas and skills to the group. In the second quarter of 2026, a BOD retreat is planned to revise our incorporating documents, plan a sustainable fiscal model, and chart the course for PopUpShow in 2026 and beyond.

## **Impact and Outreach**

### **Detailed account of how the organization has impacted the community**

Playing free and open-to-the-public live music events in New Mexico offers transformative benefits for people with mental and physical disabilities, seniors, and disadvantaged populations, as supported by extensive research. For individuals with mental health challenges, live music has been shown to significantly reduce symptoms of anxiety and depression. Engaging with live music fosters a sense of community and belonging, which is crucial for mental well-being. For those with physical disabilities, live music events provide an opportunity for social interaction and cultural enrichment, offering experiences that transcend physical limitations and promote a sense of normalcy and inclusion. The rhythmic and melodic stimulation can also improve motor skills and coordination, providing therapeutic benefits that go beyond mere entertainment.

Seniors and disadvantaged populations similarly reap immense rewards from such inclusive cultural activities. For seniors, live music events can counteract feelings of isolation and loneliness by offering social engagement in a stimulating environment. Studies highlight that musical participation helps enhance cognitive function and memory retention among older adults, thereby improving overall quality of life. Disadvantaged communities, often lacking access to such enriching experiences, benefit from the emotional uplift and cultural exposure that live music provides. The shared experience of a live performance can foster community spirit and resilience, creating moments of joy and unity that are particularly vital in overcoming socioeconomic challenges. Thus, free and public live music events in Valencia County are not just a cultural asset but a vital resource for enhancing mental, physical, and emotional well-being across diverse populations.

### **Success stories**

In this section, I'd like to briefly describe two communities that have expressed both joy and excitement upon discovering PopUpShow. In a remarkable success story, a group of talented musicians established a non-profit organization that not only ensures they receive a fair wage for their artistry but also provides a level of compensation surpassing that of typical gigs in Albuquerque or Santa Fe. This innovative model prioritizes the value of their craft and fosters a supportive community where musicians are genuinely appreciated. The organization's commitment to fair pay, combined with its focus on

creating high-energy, engaging performances, leads to a powerful energy exchange between the performers and the audience. This dynamic interaction invigorates both the musicians and attendees, generating a vibrant atmosphere that amplifies the overall experience, making each performance a memorable event for all involved.

Valencia County community and senior centers have celebrated a remarkable revival by partnering with the non-profit organization PopUpShow to reintroduce live music into their venues, an essential lifeline that had been wiped out during the pandemic. Patrons of these centers, having experienced the void left by the absence of live performances, eagerly voiced their yearning for musical events. The collaboration with PopUpShow has not only met this demand but exceeded expectations, bringing a series of vibrant, live performances that have rekindled the joy and connection that music uniquely fosters. This partnership has reinvigorated community spirit and provided seniors and local residents with a long-awaited outlet for cultural engagement and emotional enrichment, transforming their centers into bustling hubs of musical celebration and social interaction once more.

## **Data on people reached**

- Regular announcements of free and open to the public live-music events in the Valencia News-Bulletin (currently the fifth largest newspaper in New Mexico) reaches a distribution of over 22,500
- Thousands of spectators at PopUpShow events have been exposed to the therapeutic benefits of music while simultaneously hearing the message of the organization and its sponsors
- Valencia County Community and Senior Centers have seen an increased attendance during PopUpShow events over previous years
- Seven new venues added since our inceptions means an exponential increase in community impact!
- Seventeen diverse performances and thirty-four spectators was a great start to our monthly Open Mic events that began in November
- Over two-hundred nine free guitar lessons were provided by PopUpShow at the Belen Public Library. Four students remained committed for one year, and received their own guitar as a gift from the Friends of the Belen Public Library

Once again, we fell significantly short of our donations target for the year. Although funds were limited to less than our expectations, we were able to follow through with more than the originally planned events. This amazing result was made possible by the gracious generosity of many musicians who donated their time to the organization in the spirit of helping achieve the goal of re-establishing the live-music atmosphere in New Mexico. PopUpShow was also pleasantly surprised that our venue footprint was more than doubled by partner venues that were attracted to the contagious enthusiasm of live-music and their patrons.

# **Future Goals and Plans**

## **Short-term and long-term goals**

In the short-term, PopUpShow would like to enhance its grant procurement capabilities. In order for the organization to become sustainable, we cannot continue to count on the sacrifices of volunteers in order to deliver great live-music events in the community. While our Donors have been supportive, we cannot rely on their donations alone. Our board of directors is developing ideas to be discussed at our upcoming meeting.

We are excited about thinking long-term, and in addition to adding more musical talent and even more venues, PopUpShow is looking to develop a more engaged and active board of directors. There are many talents among our current board, and identifying areas for their increased contribution will help build a sustainable organization that can continue to engage with the varied communities in New Mexico in such an important manner.

## **Upcoming projects or initiatives**

PopUpShow looks forward to continuing its growth with the Adelante Development Center and other similar organizations (e.g. La Vida Felicidad, Los Lunas). We are also interested in partnering with more senior residential facilities. A new relationship with local churches in the area, holds promise for such outreach. We hope that our grant writing efforts contribute to a more fully funded 2026.

A collaborative bond was enhanced with our fiscal agent, the Valencia County Literacy Council through a contract for services with VCLC's Administrative Director Devon Hoffman. Thank you Devon for helping PopUpShow towards sustainability. We are excited that we greatly exceeded expectations by expanding our scope to include audiences of all abilities, and more than doubled our venue footprint. By bringing live-music to the community, we were able to communicate our gratitude to our sponsors, as well as deliver their message directly to our audiences.
